

Senior Chair Report – Brian Brown

At the USAS convention the Scholastic All-America committee was challenged to come up with a more equitable standard than the Sectional times (which are very different nationwide) for consideration for this honor. The committee was asked to use either an average of the Sectional time standards or the old Junior National standard (as the NCSA uses). They were also petitioned by those at the meeting to only have time standards and not make participation in certain meets compulsory to qualify for the honor (the case when an athlete establishes a qualifying and then is unable to compete due to injury was cited).
